Christmas Past Experience outline:

- Introduction to the site and setting the scene to the session and historical period.
- This session is delivered in character. Your group will be guided to the front door of Georgian Houses (accessed from High Street through the front door of Wilberforce House Museum) and will be greeted by Mrs Miggins, the Victorian Housekeeper.
- Children will help Mrs Miggins prepare the house for Christmas by taking part in a range of activities, including decorating the Christmas tree and hallway, laying the table and listening to a story.
- Back in the Education Room at Wilberforce House Museum, the group will make their own pomander to take back to school.
- Plenary and evaluation.

Important information to help you prepare:

• Gallery activities – your class will be split into three groups. We recommend that you bring a minimum of three adults per class with you to ensure each group is supported.

Key Vocabulary

Post Visit Activity Suggestions

- Look at a range of Victorian Christmas cards and then create your own using a range of craft materials.
- Gather around your Christmas tree at school and sing traditional Christmas carols.
- Take inspiration from a range of Christmas stories and have a go at writing their own based on their visit to Georgian Houses.
