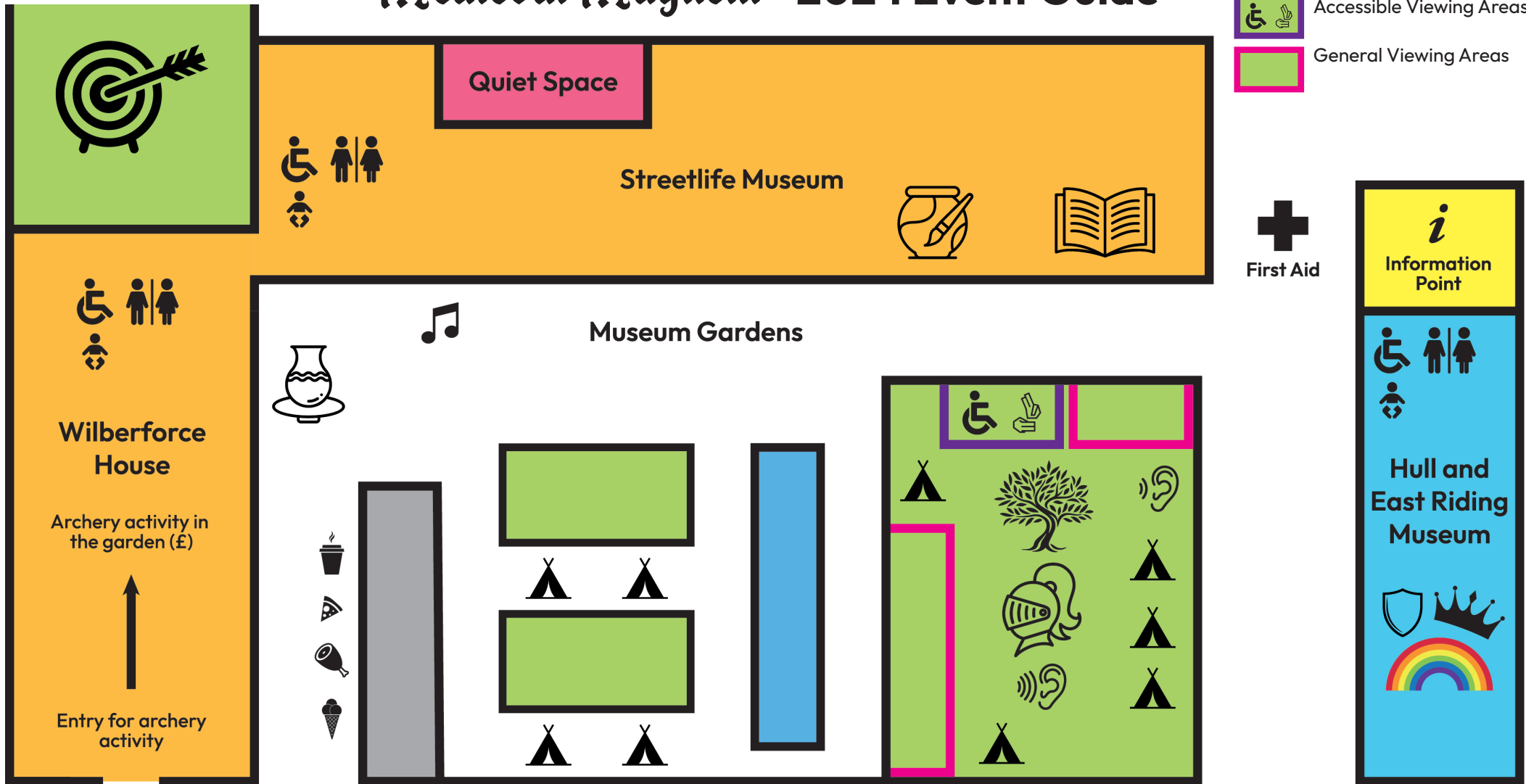
The have a go archery activity will run in the Wilberforce House gardens 10am - 12.30pm and 1pm - 3.30pm.
