There is Blue Badge parking on Gandhi Way and Alfred Gelder Street. There is also short stay pay and display parking on Lowgate.

Minibus parking is available nearby by calling 01482 616661.

The nearest bus stops (165m away) are on Alfred Gelder Street (routes 173,3,14,82 and in the other direction 8, 56, 57,173, X7).

Hull Railways station is 0.7 miles/1.1km away.

You can book a wheelchair accessible taxi by calling Wheelchair Taxi Transport Hull on 01482 473235.





The museum is made up of neighbouring former houses; Wilberforce House and Georgian Houses. There is level access to the ground floor galleries and a lift to the first floor galleries. Access to the first floor silver, local craftsmanship and clock galleries is via 2 steps from the Wilberforce House side. This part of the museum cannot be accessed by a separate lift.

 An Accessible Toilet is available on the ground floor at the rear of the building.

 Our nearest Changing Places Toilet are at the Guildhall (160m away) and Trinity Market (500m away)

 Baby Change facilities are available in the accessible toilet.
