There is designated Blue Badge parking on South Church Side. There is also a multistory car park and further on street parking on Marketplace.

Mini-buses can drop off outside the building.

The nearest bus stops (500m away) are on Monument Bridge (1, 1C, 55, 55A, 63, 66, 66B, 152, 153, 154) going towards the station, other bus routes available from Alfred Gelder Street (going to East Hull) or Bond Street (to West Hull).

Hull Railway station is 0.6 miles/1.0km away.

You can book a wheelchair accessible taxi by calling Wheelchair Taxi Transport Hull on 01482 473235.



The ground floor is mostly level access apart from the Victorian laundry which is down a flight of steps and the storytelling area, which is up a flight of steps. These are both at the far end of the Victorian gallery.

Access to the Education room and lift is via a ramp.

An Accessible Toilet is available on the first floor near the lift and stairs.

Our nearest Changing Places Toilet is at Trinity Market (80m away)
