] There is Blue Badge parking on Gandhi Way and Alfred Gelder Street. There is also short stay pay and display parking on Lowgate.

Minibus parking is available nearby by calling 01482 616661.

The nearest bus stops (165m away) are on Alfred Gelder Street (routes 173,3,14,82 and in the other direction 8, 56, 57,173, X7).

Hull Railways station is 0.8 miles/1.3km away.

There is a lift to the first floor galleries.




Assistance dogs are welcome
