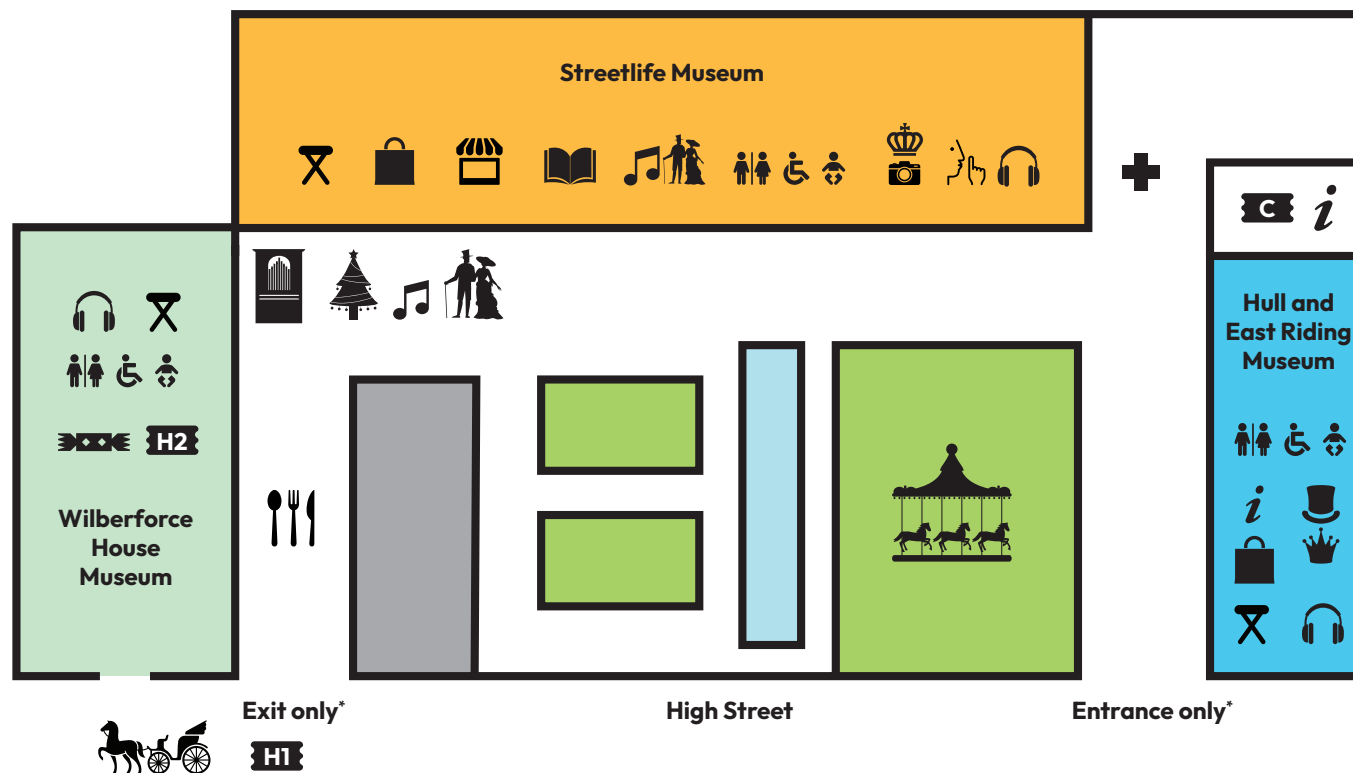

- 👤** **Quiet space** - A small room for anyone in need of a quieter environment. Please ask at the front desk of the Streetlife Museum if you would like access.
- 👂** A small number of ear defenders and sensory resources are available to borrow from the front desk of each site.
- 🪑** **Portable stools** - a small number of these can be borrowed from the front desk of the labelled sites for people who may find it difficult to stand during performances.

Toilets **🚻**
 There are toilets including baby change and accessible toilets in each museum.

The nearest **Changing Places** are at The Guildhall on Alfred Gelder Street and in Trinity Market (accessed via a RADAR key which can be collected from any market vendor.)
