There is Blue Badge parking on Gandhi Way and Alfred Gelder Street. There is also short stay pay and display parking on Lowgate.

Minibus parking is available outside by calling 01482 616661.

The nearest bus stops (165m away) are on Alfred Gelder Street (routes 173,3,14,82 and in the other direction 8, 56, 57,173, X7).

Hull Railways station is 0.8 miles/1.3km away.



There is level access to the shop.

The ground floor galleries are accessible via a platform lift or 6 steps.

There is a lift to the first floor galleries.



BSL of the information panels and Audio description of the craft films are available upstairs in the medieval gallery.



Assistance dogs are welcome



There is an Induction Loops at the front desk and a portable one is available for events.



BSL interpretation is available for talks and tours



WC An Accessible Toilet is available in the set of toilets near the shop.



Baby Change facilities are available Roman gallery toilets A temporary changing table is also available in the Ladies toilet near the shop (due to space).



Our nearest Changing Places Toilet are at the Guildhall (300m away) and Trinity Market (500m away)
