There is Blue Badge parking on Gandhi Way and Alfred Gelder Street. There is also short stay pay and display parking on Lowgate.

Minibus parking is available nearby by calling 01482 616661.

The nearest bus stops (165m away) are on Alfred Gelder Street (routes 173,3,14,82 and in the other direction 8, 56, 57,173, X7).

You can book a wheelchair accessible taxi by calling Wheelchair Taxi Transport Hull on 01482 473235.

Hull Railways station is 0.8 miles/1.3km away.



There is level access to the shop. The ground floor galleries are accessible via a platform lift or 5 steps.

There is a lift to the first floor galleries.

BSL interpretation is available for talks and tours



An Accessible Toilet is available at the toilets near the shop.



Baby Change facilities are available in Roman gallery toilets.
