An annual meeting to ensure your school get the most from your package, mapping the Magical Museum programme to your curriculum and helping to support your school's specific priorities.

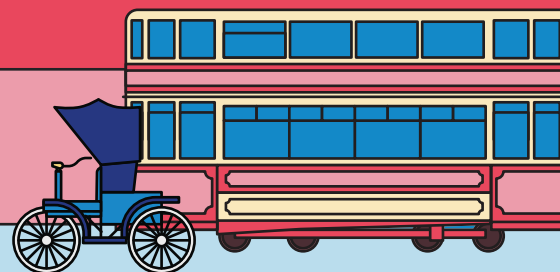
